

Michigan Nature Association 2019-2020 Nature Field Trip Grant Application

The Michigan Nature Association announces the availability of \$500 grants for field trips to natural areas for the 2019-2020 school year. These grants are intended to assist teachers in developing fun, educational, and hands-on field trips for teaching students about the natural environment. The grants can cover bus transportation and educational supplies for field trips to eligible natural areas, including community nature centers, MNA sanctuaries, state parks, or other conservation lands deemed suitable for field trips. MNA is especially interested in applications from schools with limited access to and ability to visit natural areas. APPLICATION DEADLINES: Wednesday, September 11 for 2019 fall trips; Friday, February 28 for 2020 spring trips

PAYMENT: Successful applicants will receive \$400 of the \$500 grant up front. Recipients must submit photos to the Michigan Nature Association for digital and print publication. School field trip permission slips must include parental permission for distribution of photos. The remaining \$100 is paid once a final report and photos are received.
